Since joining our firm in 2021, Chaya has supported our investments in Arclight Therapeutics, ImmunOs, and Eikonizo Therapeutics through Board Observer roles. She is also active in the Boston venture ecosystem as a leader for the Emerging Venture Capitalists Association (EVCA). Prior to joining us, she was focused on venture creation at a family office, contributing to the development of Alloy Therapeutics. Chaya earned her PhD from Dartmouth, where her research advanced the understanding of creating maternal immunity to prevent neonatal viral infections.
